VOLUNTEER TRAINING FOR CHEMICAL & BACTERIA STREAM MONITORING

You do not need to be an environmentalist, fisherman, or scholar to become a water quality monitor! All are welcome to learn how to collect data that can help protect and restore freshwater streams.

This training will provide virtual classroom and hands on instruction for volunteer monitors on how to: select a monitoring site, use equipment properly, collect samples, test surface water quality, enter data, determine stream conditions and practice safety in the field.

This is a hybrid style workshop. Part 1 will be attending a 3 hour virtual presentation. Part 2 will be meeting at a stream site, in small groups, to learn how to sample and use monitoring equipment. You must be available for both parts to get certified.
